Orchard Software provides an Electronic Laboratory Results (ELR) Interface that sends reportable laboratory results to appropriate public health agencies. Here we provide evidence that interfaces in use transmit data that meets certification criterion 45 CFR 170.317(f)(3).

Over a 30 day period in Q3 of 2024, Orchard Software collected counts of the number of results that qualified as reportable results and the number of results transmitted to the public health agency of two laboratories using:
